Covid 19: We began services on June 6. We have Liturgy at 5pm Saturday and 10 am Sunday. We are limiting attendance 15 **families** at each service. Please let Father Dennis know if you plan on attending, so that we can keep our numbers to a level where we can social distance. Families should sit together. Keep at least 6 feet from other families and individuals. You **must** wear a mask. If you come to communion, remove your mask and immediately put it back on after receiving.

You are still not required to come to Liturgy, as that obligation is suspended until further notice. If you come to Liturgy, you do not have to receive communion.

I have spoken to two medical authorities, who have told me that the possibility of contracting the virus through the reception of communion is extremely heightened.

The general laws of nature, that our Lord created, are not suspended in the church. You can contract this virus as easily in the church as you can anywhere else.
