- Eversource: \$860.82 for electricity for Church, Church Hall, outside lights, barn, and rectory
- Laurence Candle: \$1,158.30 for candles for the church and the Saint Jude Shrine
- Cleaning: \$125.00 for the cleaning of the Church, Church Hall, conference room, bathrooms, and Church hall kitchen. Also, for set up and extra cleaning before and after Order of Malta visit last Saturday.

Total bills paid the last week: \$2,144.12. Total collected last week \$2,232.00. We had a surplus last week of \$87.88. For the Fiscal Year, which began September 1, 2023; we have a surplus of \$111.12 in 28 weeks.
