Jesus' Words from the Cross: On the Third Sunday of Lent, we contemplate the beautiful words our dying Lord spoke to His mother and to Saint John, the beloved disciple: "When Jesus saw his mother, and the disciple whom He loved standing near, He said to His mother, 'Woman, behold your son!' Then He said to the disciple, 'Behold, your mother!' And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home." (John 19: 26-27).

It might seem strange that Jesus calls His mother "Woman", which, to our ears, sounds rather disrespectful. But in the Jewish culture at that time, "Woman" was actually a dignified form of address, conveying honor and respect.

Moreover, let's think about where else in Scripture we've heard someone called "woman". In Genesis 3:15, God curses the serpent for his deception: "I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your seed and her seed…" God is proximately referring to Eve, whom the serpent deceived; but more importantly, He is referencing the Theotokos, whose seed, Jesus Christ, will destroy the power of the serpent. So when Christ calls His mother "Woman", He is evoking her role as the new Eve, through whom the promise of a Redeemer is fulfilled.

When Jesus says, "Behold your son.", He is referring not only to Saint John, but to all of us. The timing of this address is critical. Remember that Jesus is dying. He says these words as He is literally being sacrificed for our redemption. He speaks as He is opening the doors of the Kingdom, as he is making us sons and daughters of God again.

In a concurrent way, He is also referencing mankind's newfound unity with Himself. The Church is His Mystical Body, made so through His suffering and death; and just as the Theotokos is His mother, so she is the mother of His members.

By addressing both His mother and Saint John (that is, us), Jesus is not just assigning titles. He is establishing a relationship. We are Mary's children now. She is truly our mother. She will care for us, teach us, and protect us as we grow spiritually and journey towards Heaven. But a relationship goes two ways. We can't call Mary our mother and then treat her as an afterthought. Rather, we are called to love and honor her. Bring her your joys, sorrows, and problems. Ask for her guidance and wisdom in every path you take. Thank her for her unending "yes" to God.

Lighting candles: We have two candle stands in the front of the church. I would like to encourage everyone to light a candle before Liturgy.

Please light a candle every week, if possible. A donation of \$1.00 per candle is requested to cover the cost of the pure beeswax candles and to allow the church to make a small profit on them. Thank you---Father Dennis
