- Frontier Communications: \$280.59 paid early for April's bill which was not due until April 22
- Father Dennis' Salary: \$2,383.22 for March
- Eparchy: \$3,063.15 for March's assessment. medical insurance for Father Dennis and Lisa, and the priest retirement fund
