Financial update; bills paid last week:

- Sewer bill: \$247.00 for the period 2/27/24 to 5/30/24
- Water bill: \$129.54 for the period 2/27/24 to 5/30/24
- Bulletins: \$216.00 for last two quarters
- Copier rental: \$163.81
- Rectory air conditioner: \$1,500.00 paid for new central air conditioner. The old one was beyond repair. We still owe \$2,845.00
- Orkin Pest Control: \$194.61 for insect and rodent preventative treatment
- Household: \$495.28 for three weeks of food.
- Property Insurance: \$1,500.00. We still owe \$7,414.00 payable by the end of the year.

We spent \$3,096.24.24. Our deficit for the fiscal year, which began 9/1/23, is now \$8,941.18 in 44 weeks.
